#### 1) Divisions & Categories

- Korean part (Division A, B) and English part (Division C)
- Each school can nominate up to 15 students depends on the 'Number of Korean language students' in the school

- Candidates, who fit in both category 3 & 6 can choose one of their preference
- Candidates, who fit in both category 4 & 7 can choose one of their preference
- Category 5 & 8 no limitation for number of applicants

## 2) Guidelines

- Theme, Time, Genre and Requirements

  - Time and Genre: 90mins, all genres are acceptable except for poems
  - Monolingual and /or bilingual print dictionaries may be used

## 4. Award

- **Grand Prize** Korean (Division A & B) for one student: Prize Certificates will be signed by the Minister of Culture, Sports and Tourism of the Republic of Korea & \$300 voucher
- **Grand Prize** English (Division C) for one student: Prize Certificates will be signed by the Minister of NSW Department of Education & \$300 voucher
- **1<sup>st</sup> prize** from all categories (1~8) will receive an award from the Consul General of the Republic of Korea with \$200 voucher
- **2<sup>nd</sup> prize** from all categories (1~8) will receive an award from Director of the Korean Cultural Centre with \$100 voucher
- All participants will receive a certificate and a gift
